

HATFIELD HYDE CRICKET CLUB

Data Protection Statement

In line with the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulations 2018, Hatfield Hyde Cricket Club will collect personal information provided by playing and non-playing members on the Club's Membership Application Form for the purpose of communication of Club fixtures and training sessions. Specific consent for the use of this personal information for the communication of any other events and activities being organised by, or in connection with, the Club will be recorded on the Application Form.

The information will be limited to name and home address, date of birth, gender, school (for junior members), telephone numbers, email addresses(s) and any social media profiles. Emergency contact details and disclosure of medical conditions will also be requested.

The information will be held until the member no longer has an association with the club or a request to delete the information is received.

All data will be held on relevant databases with password protected access for club officials and team captains only.

All members have the right to view their personal data held on the database within one month of making a request for access and can withdraw their consent to the use of that information by providing a written request to the Club Secretary. Any complaints about the use of personal data should be addressed to the Club Secretary.

In some cases, the Club may be required to disclose the information to County Boards, Leagues and the England and Wales Cricket Board. In the event of a medical issue or child protection issue arising, the Club may disclose certain information to doctors and other medical specialists and/or to police, children's social care, the Courts and/or probation officers and potentially to legal and other advisers involved in an investigation

The person completing the membership form must ensure that each person whose information they include in this form knows what will happen with this information and how it may be disclosed.
